WOODMAN TALKS WITH DAVID DUKER

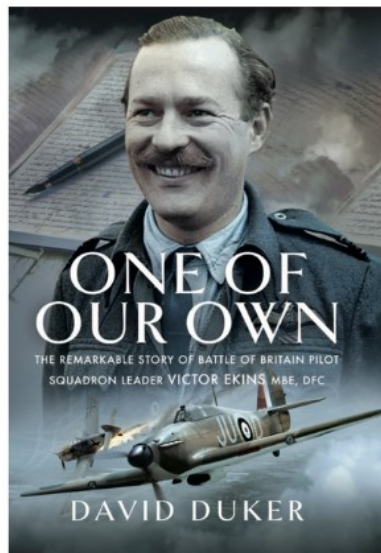
On Wednesday 31st January 2024 at 8pm start.
